



## Close to 25 ~ A Game for 2 Players

Close to 20 is played by using two sets of cards numbered 1 to 10 and recording sheets.

- Each player is dealt 5 cards
- Each player then chooses three of three cards to make a sum as close to 25 as possible (but not more than 25).
- A player's score for the round is the difference between his or her combination and 25.
- On the recording sheet, each player writes his or her combinations, the total of the combination and the score for the round (25 minus the total).
- At the end of the round, each player discards the cards used to make this first combination and receives three new cards. Play continues for five rounds.
- As students try to get Close to 25, they are trying to have the lowest possible score.
- The scores for the 5 rounds are added.
- The player with the lowest total score is the winner of the game.
